Toronto City Planning Division invites you to attend a Community Meeting regarding the status of "Mimico 2020", an ongoing revitalization initiative for the Mimico-By-The-Lake community.

Project Status

Since the last update in April 2011, the Project Consultant and City Staff Team have been working to gain a deeper understanding of the key policy issues that will influence future planning in Mimico:

- 1) Waterfront Access: expansion of waterfront, open space and street network
- 2) Housing: options for retention and replacement of rental housing
- 3) Density: appropriate built form and magnitude of development over the study area
- 4) Heritage: preservation of potentially significant built and cultural heritage features

It has become apparent that any future implementation strategy will require a balancing of objectives in order to achieve the ultimate goal of revitalization in a manner that is consistent with the vision and priorities defined to date, including the April 2009 Charette.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide a status update, and to hear from you at this critical juncture, prior to proceeding with a draft final policy framework.
