#### PURPOSE OF THE APPLICATION:

To construct a new detached dwelling with an attached garage and a rear inground pool.

#### REQUESTED VARIANCE(S) TO THE ZONING BY-LAW:

#### 1. Section 330-23.A.(9)

The maximum permitted floor space index is 0.35 times the lot area (358.24 m<sup>2</sup>). The new dwelling will have a floor space index of 0.49 times the lot area (501.6 m<sup>2</sup>).

#### 2. Section 330-23.A.(10)(a)

The maximum permitted height is 9.5 m to the top of the roof. The new dwelling will have a height of 10.05 m to the top of the roof.

#### THE COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT & MINOR VARIANCES

The role of the Committee of Adjustment is to provide flexibility in dealing with minor adjustments to zoning bylaw requirements. To approve such variances, the Committee must be satisfied that:

- the variance requested is minor;
- the proposal is desirable for the appropriate development or use of the land and/or building;
- the general intent and purpose of the City's Zoning Code and/or By-law are maintained; and
- the general intent and purpose of the Official Plan are maintained.

The Committee of Adjustment forms its opinion through its detailed review of all material filed with an application, letters received, deputations made at the public hearing and results of site inspections.

The notice has been mailed to you, as required by the *Planning Act*, to ensure that, as an interested person, you may make your views known by:

- Attending the Public Hearing. Attendant Care Services can be made available with some advance notice.

  receive your views on the relevant issue(s) to enable the Committee to make its decision on this matter. This
  information will become part of the public record.

If you do not attend the public hearing, or express your views in writing, the Committee may make a decision in your absence, and may recommend changes to the proposal
