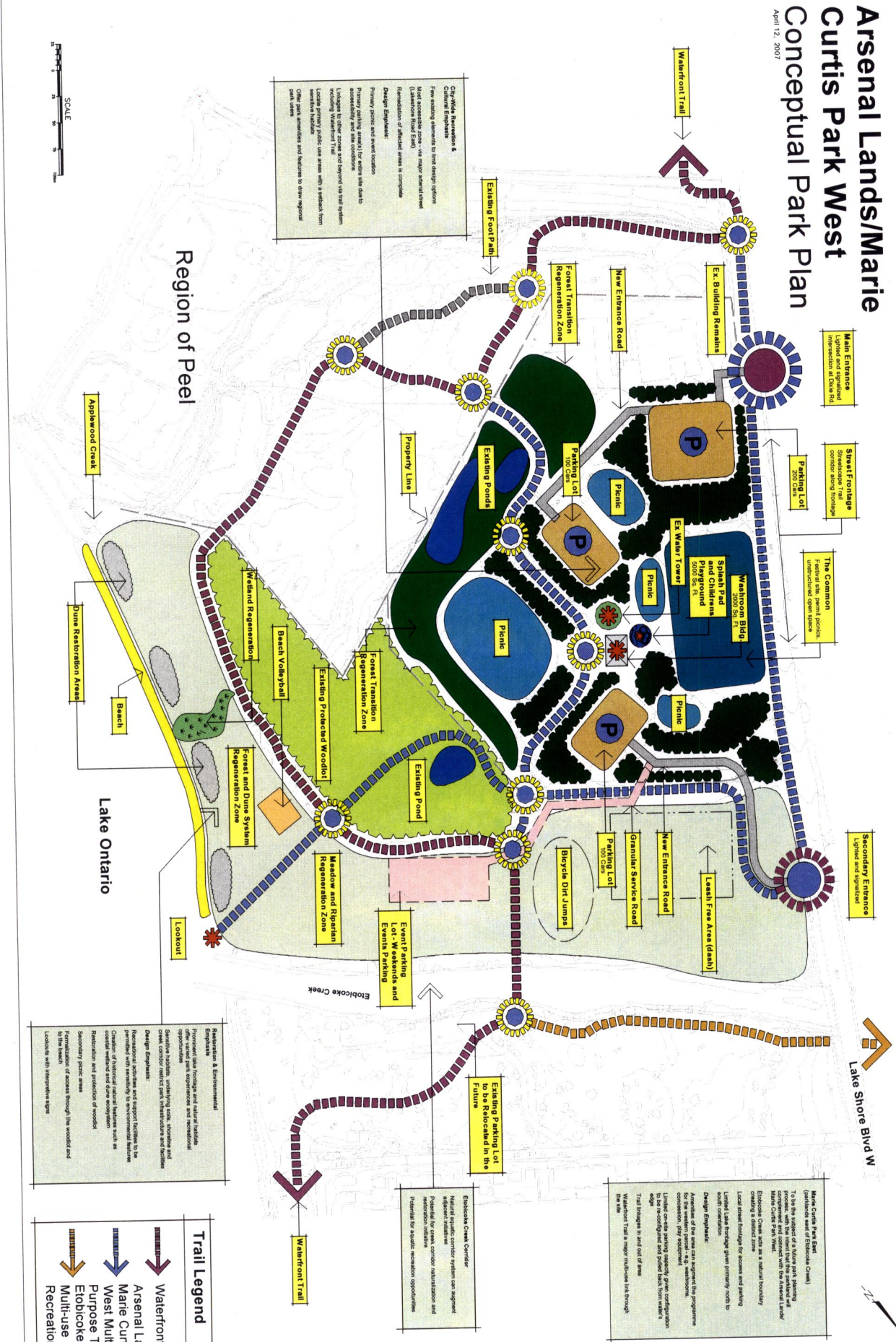


Arsenal Lands/Marie Curtis Park West

Restoration & Environmental
 This plan includes existing and natural features offer varied park experience and recreational opportunities.
 Strategic habitat, including oak, spruce and oak, cedar or maple park, (wetlands and riparian).
Design Emphasis:
 Recreation areas and support building to the center of natural habitat. Wetlands, oak forest, wetland and stream ecosystem.
 Restoration and protection of woodlot.
 Secondary zone areas.
 Protection of access through the woodlot and to the beach.
 Landscaping with interpretive signs.

City-Miles Recreation & Cultural Emphasis
 Few existing elements to trail design options.
 Most accessible zone - via major arterial street (Lambton Road East).
 Remediation of affected areas is complete.
Design Emphasis:
 Primary paths and event location.
 Primary parking (multi) for active site due to accessibility and site conditions.
 Linkages to other zones and beyond via trail system including waterfront trail.
 Local primary public use areas with a backdrop from other park amenities and features to other regional park users.

Main Curtis Park East (Urban park (Etobicoke Creek))
 To be the site for the main trail and parking lot. To be the site for the main trail and parking lot. To be the site for the main trail and parking lot.
Design Emphasis:
 Accession of the main car support the program for the western park - e.g. washrooms, concession, park equipment.
 Linkage to other zones and beyond via trail system including waterfront trail.
 Trail bridges to and out of area.
 Waterfront Trail a major multi-use link through the site.

Etobicoke Creek Corridor
 Natural aquatic corridor system can support adjacent habitat.
 Potential for creek corridor revitalization and restoration.
 Potential for aquatic recreation opportunities.
