Since we have committed to these costs in advance, we are not in a position to offer refunds at this point in time. **However once the event takes place, if for any reason you are unable to attend, our first priority will be to refund, proportionally any funds you paid in. These funds will be taken from any monies we have left over.**

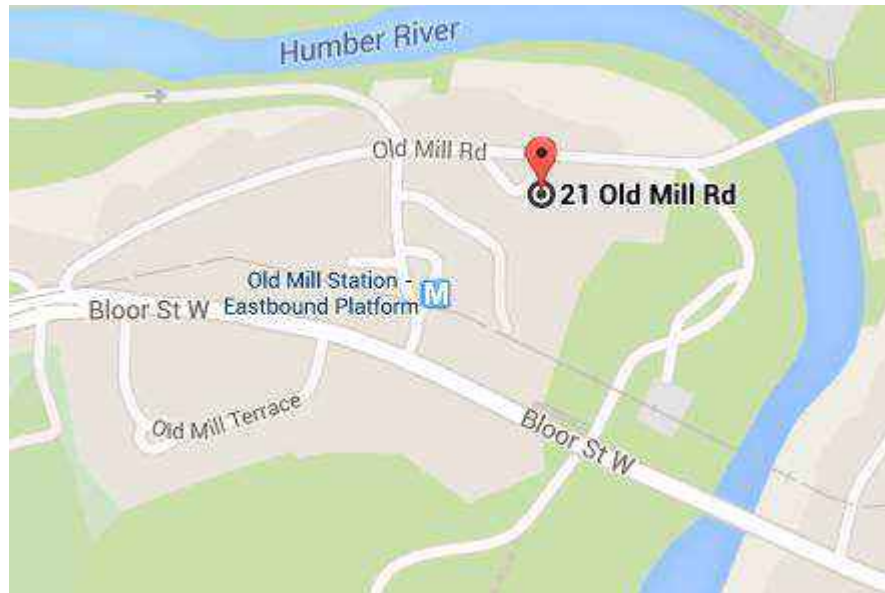

Parking is available at \$27/day/vehicle, tax in, flat rate, self-parking with in and out driving privileges, located underground our hotel driveway, just be sure to register your license plate with Front Desk any time you arrive to park.

Booking the deluxe one bedroom suites would not include the buffet breakfast however can be added on for \$14/day/person.

Below is the public transportation option using the TTC subway-line. Taking the Queen Station Northbound and transferring at Yonge/Bloor to go Westbound and getting off on the east side of Old Mill Station to the Inn.

Another option is to book a car service through our concierge or usually there are taxis in front of our hotel driveway.
