Why has the workshop been rescheduled?

We promoted this event in the *Toronto Star*, *Metro News*, community newspapers, social media, community e-newsletters, and conducted outreach to elected officials. This evening's event was planned for up to 150 participants based on pre-registration.

We learned yesterday that extensive promotion to area residents by some of our stakeholders did not include the link to register and we now expect a much higher number of people than this venue can reasonably or safely accommodate.

To ensure we have a venue that allows for everyone to meaningfully participate in this event, we have rescheduled the workshop. This was a difficult decision, and we are sorry for the inconvenience.
